▪ To develop the discussion platform in a post pandemic period how to overcome the economic crisis in Europe.

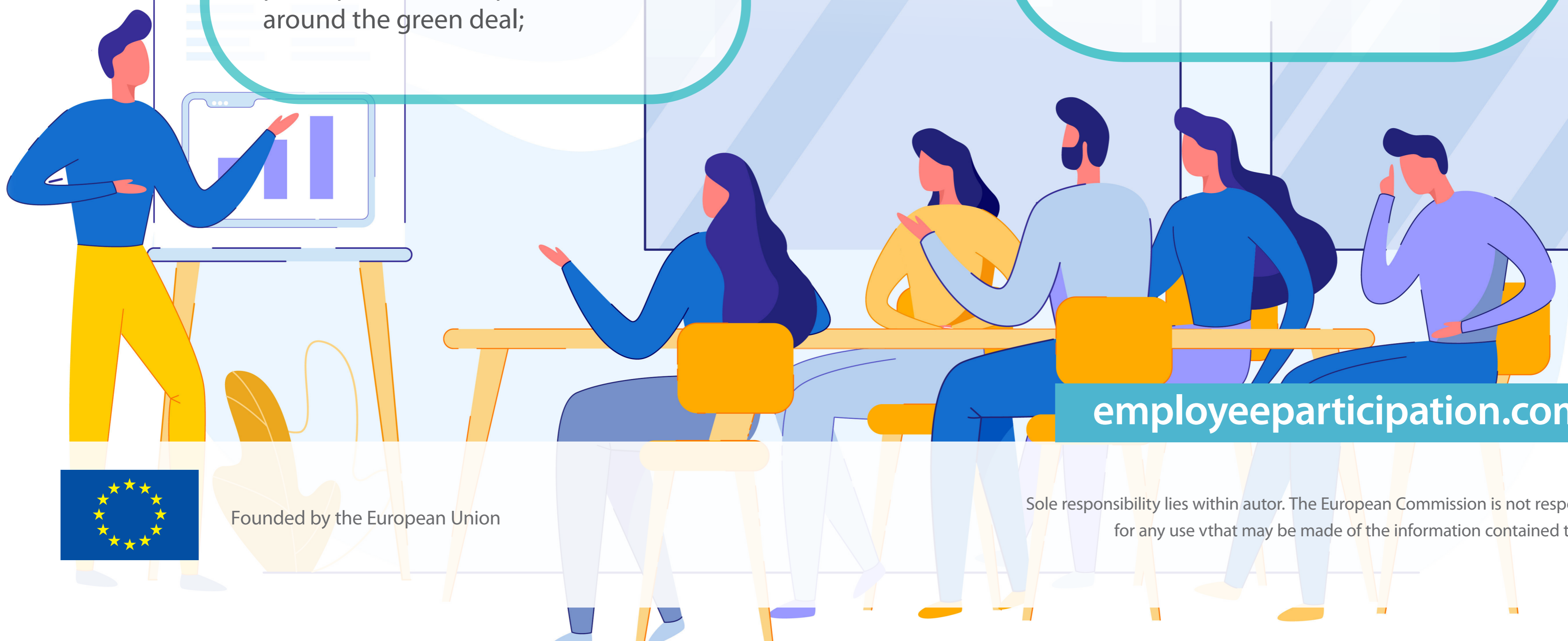


▪ To increase knowledge of representatives on the Just Transition Mechanism to better implement the policies in the organisations;
