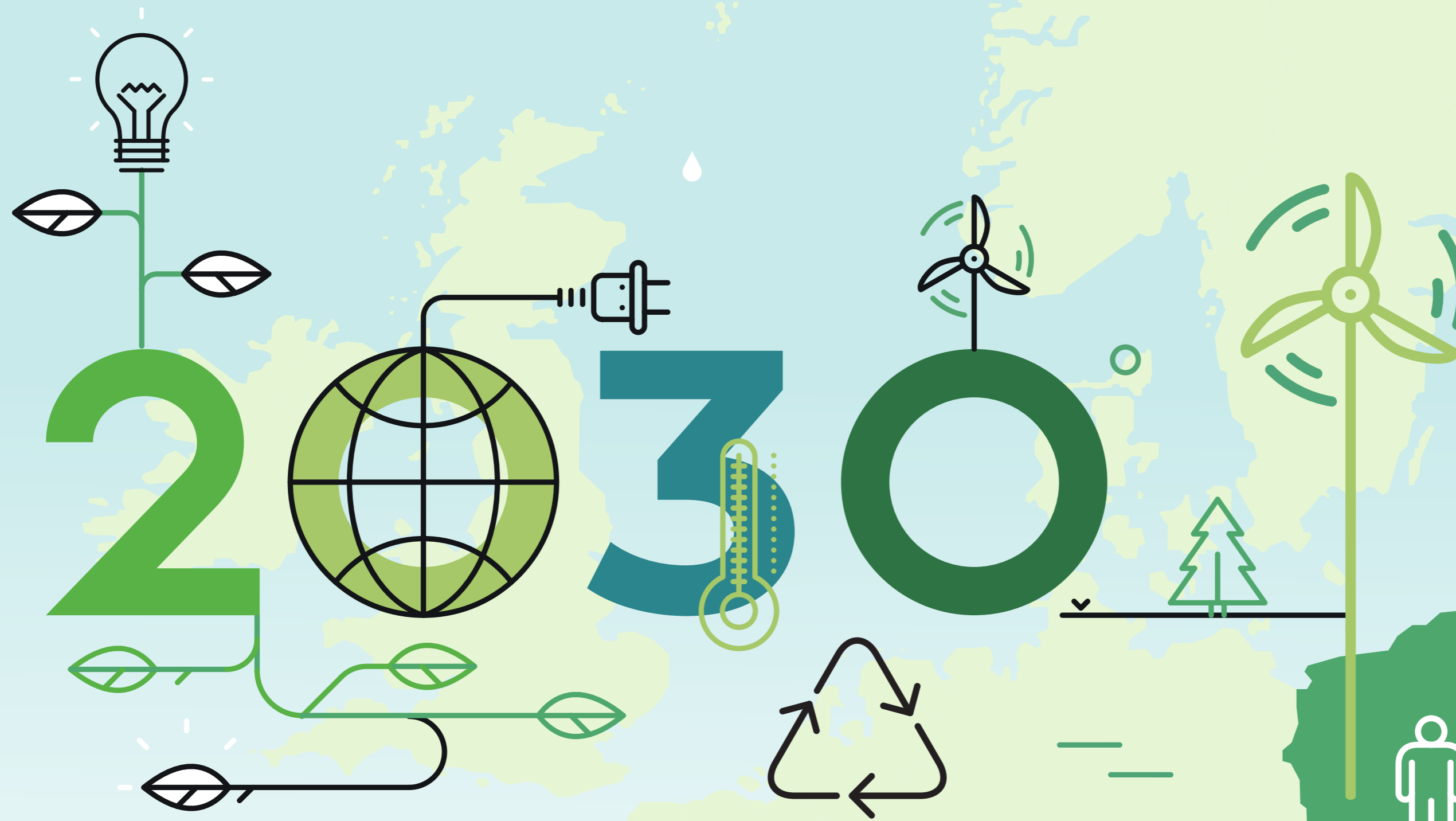




Key milestones for adopting the **European Green Deal**



December 2019: Commission presents the European Green Deal committing to climate neutrality by 2050.

March 2020: Commission proposes a 'European Climate Law' to enshrine the 2050 climate neutrality target in binding legislation. The Commission proposes a new EU net emissions reduction target of at least 55% by 2030 and adds it to the European Climate Law.

December 2020: European leaders endorse the Commission's proposed target to reduce net emissions by at least 55% by 2030.

April 2021: European Parliament and member states reach political agreement on a European climate law.

June 2021: European climate law enters into force.

July 2021: Commission presents a package of proposals (Fit for 55) to transform our economy and enable us to meet our 2030 climate targets.

The European Parliament and Member States negotiate and adopt a package of legislation to achieve our 2030 climate targets.
